The birth of the **Quintette du Hot Club de France** in 1934 was at Claridge's Hotel in the Champs Elysées. The group included the pick of the Parisian jazzmen, One day **Stephane Grappelli and Django Reinhardt** spontaneously started playing 'Dinah', just to amuse themselves. The others began to join in - Django's brother **Joseph, Roger Chaput, and Louis Vola** on bass. They were fascinated by the sound they were making. From then on, after hours they would repair to a late-night musician's hangout, the "Alsace" Brasserie in Montmartre, to carry on the pioneering work. None of the participants ever suspected the fame that lay in store for this all-strings group **QHCF** that created this lasting genre of Music – **Gypsy Jazz!**
